As the war crisis continues in Ukraine, the Virginia Baptist State Convention Disaster/Home & Foreign Missions would like to assist in helping the people who are in dire conditions. We have identified teams on the ground in Ukraine who are working diligently through the Lott Carey Foreign Missions. Together we are working to provide food, medical supplies and other necessary aid to Ukrainians who remain in the country, and aid refugee families, women with children who might be forced to relocate from their homes to safer areas or even into Poland and the Baltic states. We are asking that each constituent church receive an offering on Sunday, May 1st, 2022 for the Virginia Baptist State Convention Disaster/Home & Foreign Missions. This offering will be brought to the Annual Session and used to enhance our missional efforts and presence. We want to ensure that we can send financial assistance ASAP to meet these needs. We are grateful for your support; and may the Lord bless you and reward you greatly for your response in this time of need. "Carry each other's burdens and so you will fulfill the law of Christ." (Gal. 6:2)



Together, we sent 1,564 letters to the General Assembly, hosted a virtual week of action, met with lawmakers, raised our voices on social media, and publicly testified in support of Prison Fellowship's legislative priorities. Here is how your voice impacted legislation in Virginia: **Voting rights**: Prison Fellowship supported a proposed amendment to the Constitution of Virginia that would restore voting rights to individuals upon their release from incarceration. While the proposal did gain more bipartisan support than in previous years, it was not successful. The fight is not over—we will continue advocating for a more just approach to voting rights restoration within the Constitution of Virginia.

Occupational licensing: Prison Fellowship spearheaded a bill that would have improved the occupational licensing application and review processes for Virginians with a criminal record. We look forward to strengthening the bill in the 2023 legislative session to remove barriers to meaningful employment.

Additional reforms: Prison Fellowship also supported legislation to create a comprehensive study of in-prison fees faced by incarcerated Virginians and their loved ones, as well as the availability of work for prisoners. We also opposed measures that would have reduced access to effective incentives for rehabilitation through earned time credits and parole. Looking ahead: Prison Fellowship will continue its work to advance proportional punishment, reduce barriers to success for men and women who have rejected crime, and reestablish rehabilitation incentives that spur positive change.


