

VBSC Christian Education Leadership School



2093 A Christian View Towards the Poor Hungry, and Disadvantaged

INSTRUCTOR: Dr. Roscoe D. Cooper Jr., Richmond PARTICIPANTS: Outreach Workers and Laity

This course will teach the importance and the responsibilities of the church from a biblical perspective as they relate to the development of outreach ministries aimed at providing assistance to the underprivileged and disabled in various categories.

5012 Becoming an Effective Member of the Diaconate Ministry

INSTRUCTOR: Deacon Danny Miller, Norfolk PARTICIPANTS: Deacons and Deaconesses

This course will assist diaconate servants in becoming aware of the ministry's biblical basis. Participants will be enabled to perform their duties and work harmoniously with the pastor and other church leaders more effectively.

6017 Developing a Program for a Rural Church

INSTRUCTOR: Dr. Waddell Jones, Rustburg PARTICIPANTS: Leaders and Laypersons

Assist the rural church leader to assess the needs of the community. Emphasis is placed on the uniqueness of the rural community, resources available to the church community, and strategies for rural church development. Compare and contrast the programmatic elements of both rural and urban church ministries.

9018 Great Hymns of the Church: Their Origin and Meaning

INSTRUCTOR: Dr. Janet Kay Copeland, Richmond PARTICIPANTS: Musicians, Choir Members, and Laity

This course will make available a study on several of the great hymns of the church. The course investigates the history of the words and the music as well as the importance of the story in the song. Students will look at the meaning of the song for that day and make an application of the song for this day.

9907 Characteristics of Expository Preaching

INSTRUCTOR: Rev. Nicole Guns, Norfolk PARTICIPANTS: Licensed Clergy and Pastors

This course will seek to sharpen the preacher's expository preaching skills.

Students will look at such key research tools as word studies, biblical language skills, computer research, and the use of other sources of historical and hermeneutical value. Expository preaching, as a valuable tool in the preacher's skill set, will be presented as a tool that will sharpen the preacher's ability to research and preach a more effective sermon.

9914 Connecting the Local Church to the Community

INSTRUCTOR: Rev. H. Patrick Cason, Chesapeake PARTICIPANTS: Trustees and Finance Persons

Participants will examine the mission of the church to serve the community. They will consider the biblical mandate for the church to be missionaries to the community, and serve the spiritual, social, and physical needs of the people therein. This course will help students to better understand the spiritual nature of the church, thus creating an incentive to reach out as servants to the community.

9925 Lexical Greek

INSTRUCTOR: Dr. William D. Tyree III, Norfolk PARTICIPANTS: Christian Education and Laypersons

Participants will receive a brief introduction to Koine Greek, the language of the New Testament. Introduce students to the Greek lexicon and how to use it. Greek nouns, verb usages, and transliterations will be discussed. Students should be familiar with basic English grammar and the New Testament of the Bible.


