November 2, 2024 Last day In-Person Early Absentee Voting. After this, you must go to your precinct on Election Day.

To be Eligible to Register to Vote in Virginia a Person must:

- ◆ Be a resident of Virginia (a person who has come to Virginia for temporary purposes and intends to return to another state is not considered a resident for voting purposes).
- ◆ Be a U. S. Citizen.
- ◆ Be 18 years old (any person who is 17 years old and will be eighteen years of age at the next general election shall be permitted to register in advance and also vote in any intervening primary or special election).
- ◆ Not be registered and plan to vote in another state.
- ◆ Not currently declared mentally incompetent by a court of law.

If convicted of a felony, your right to vote must have been restored.

College Student Info:

A college student registers to vote in Virginia the same as any other applicant: every prospective vote must submit a voter registration application. Remember, you must update your voter registration information whenever you change your residence.
